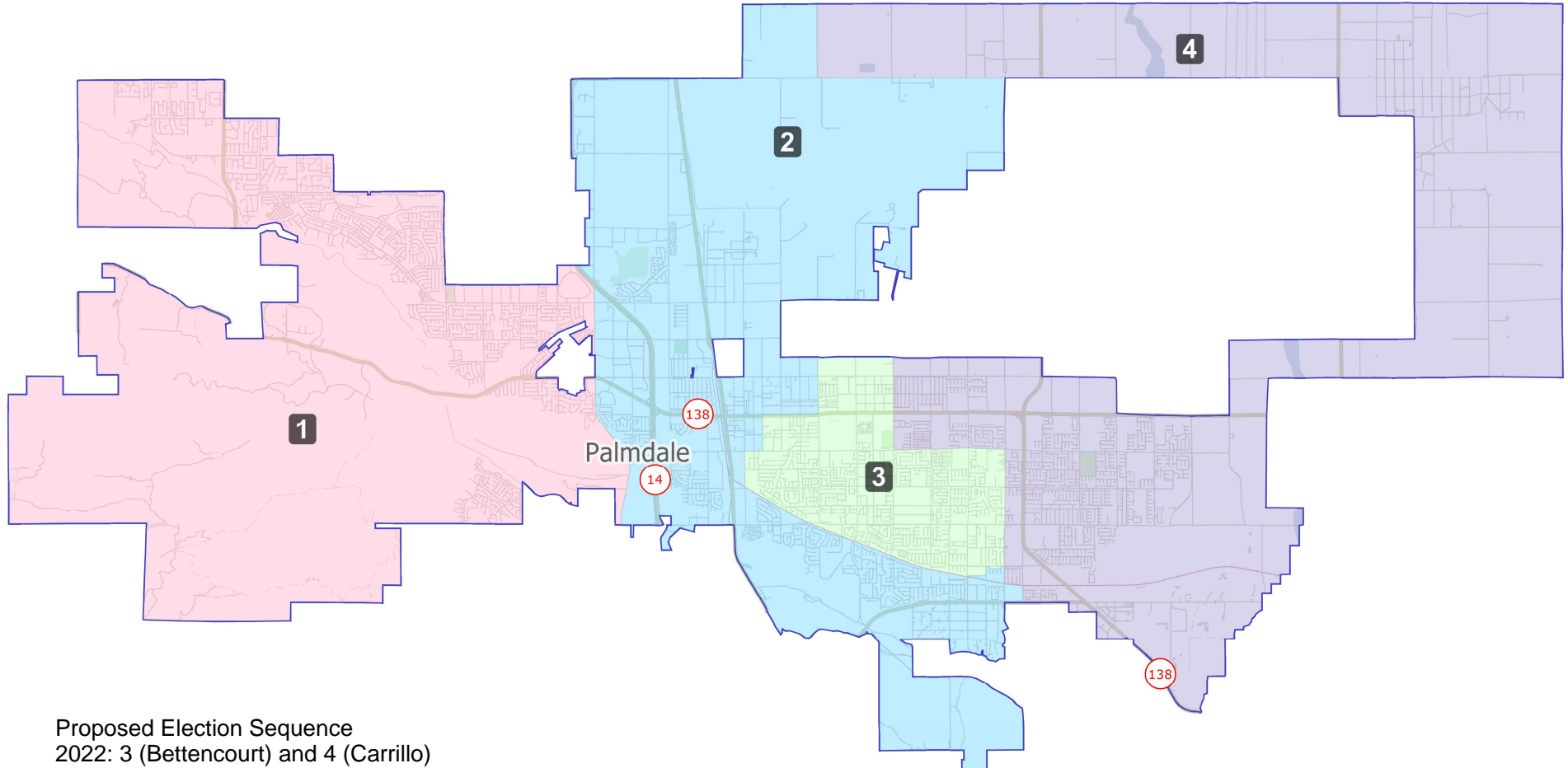

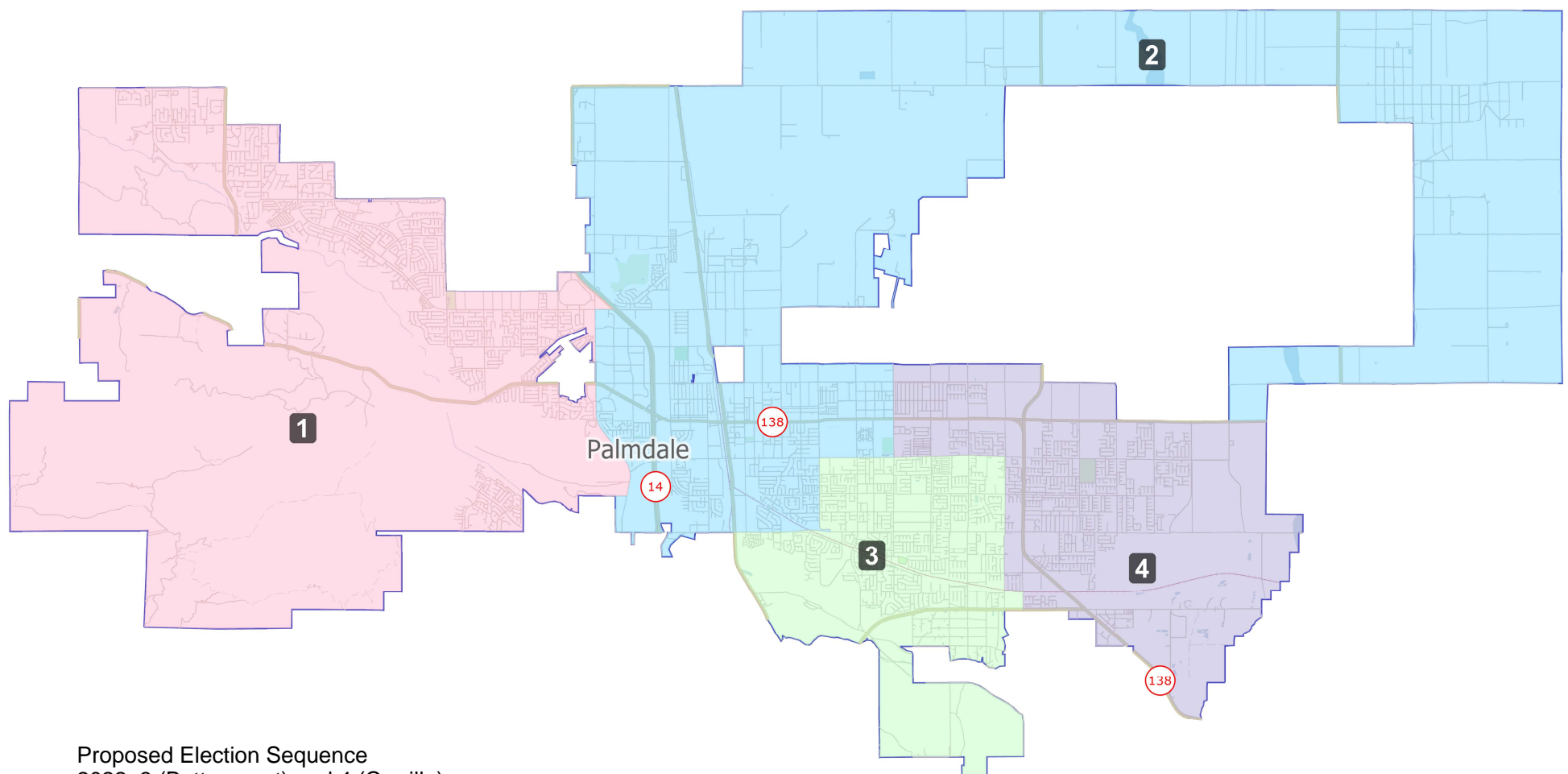
Public Map 202

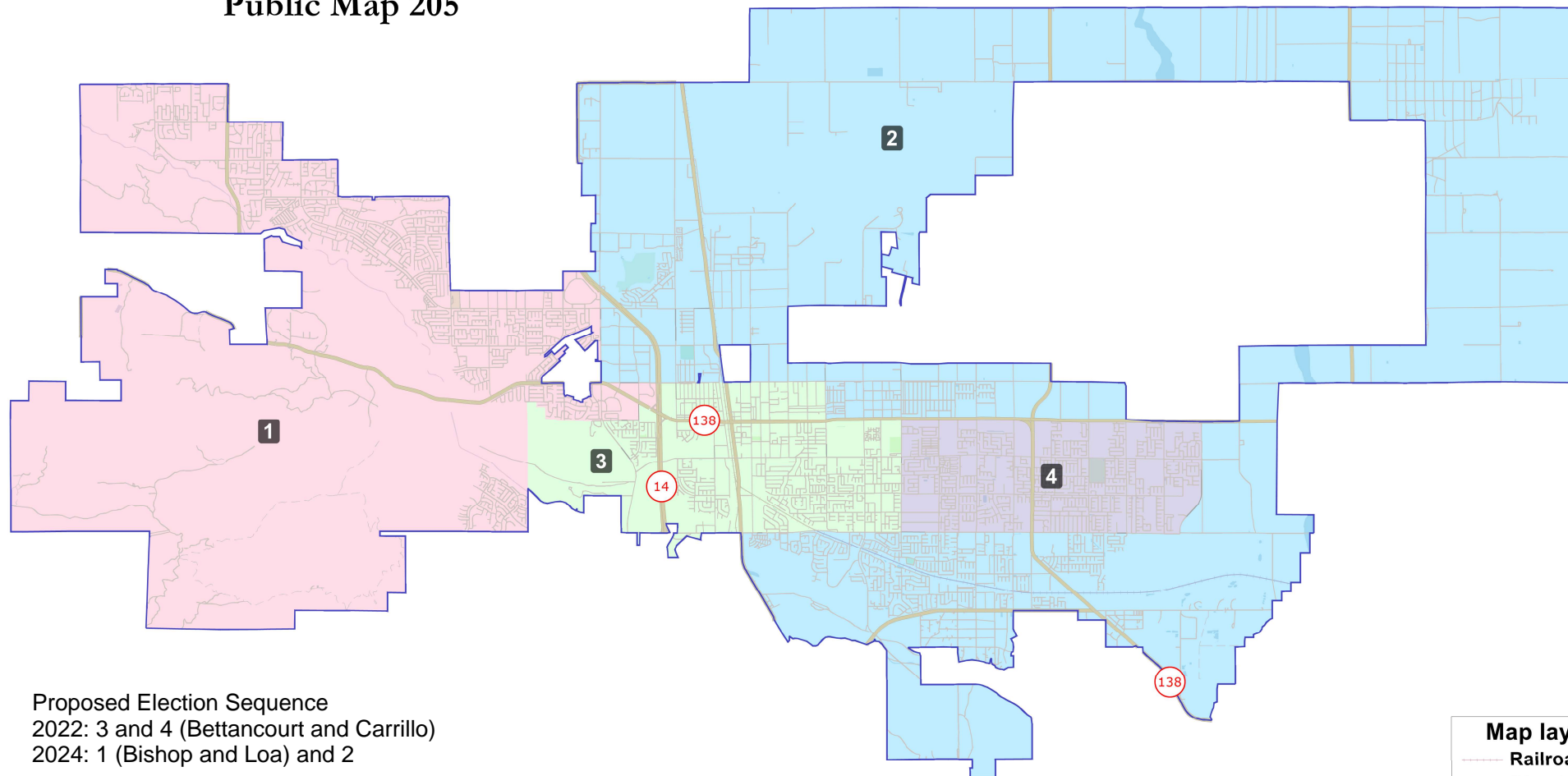

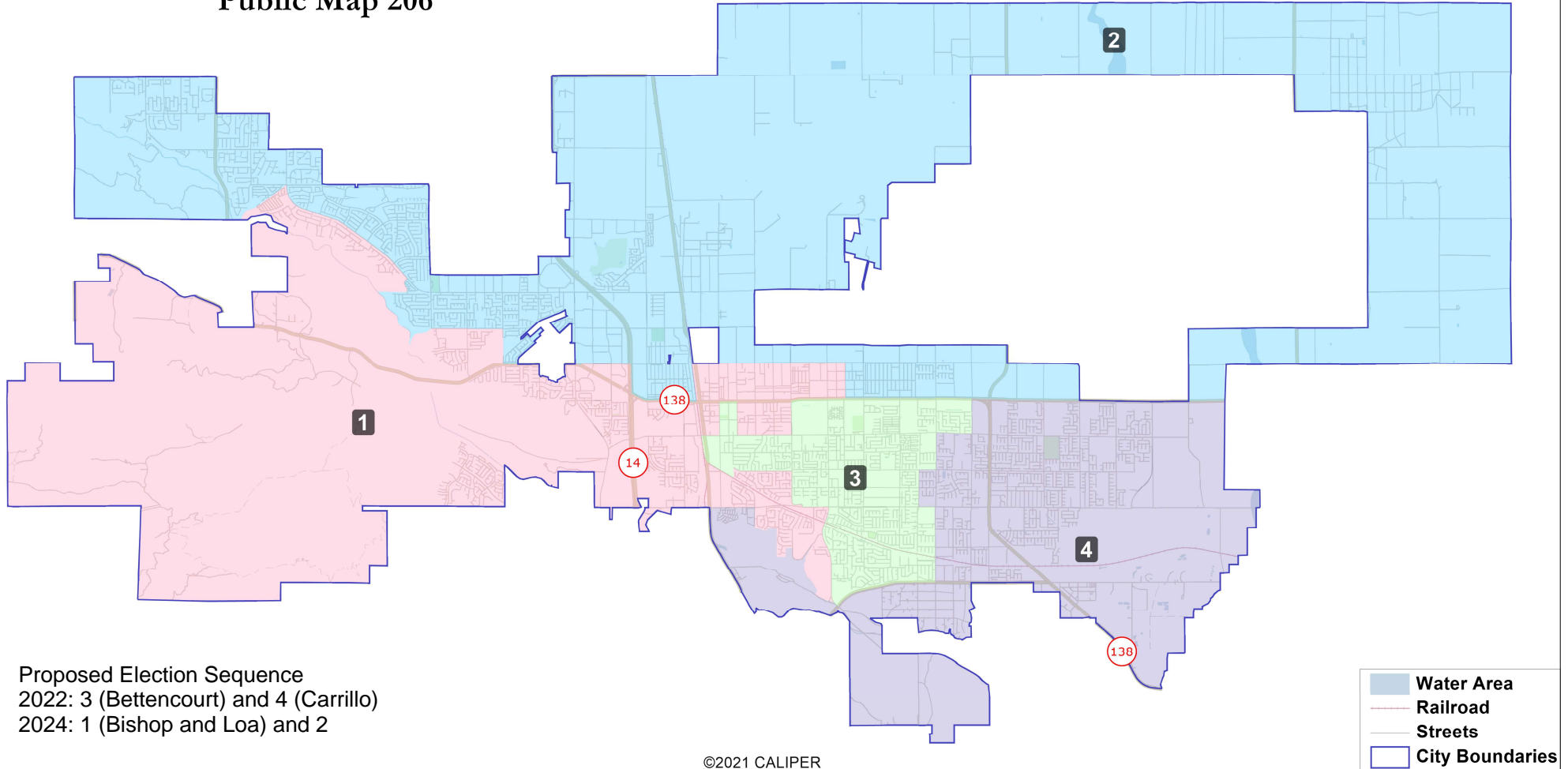

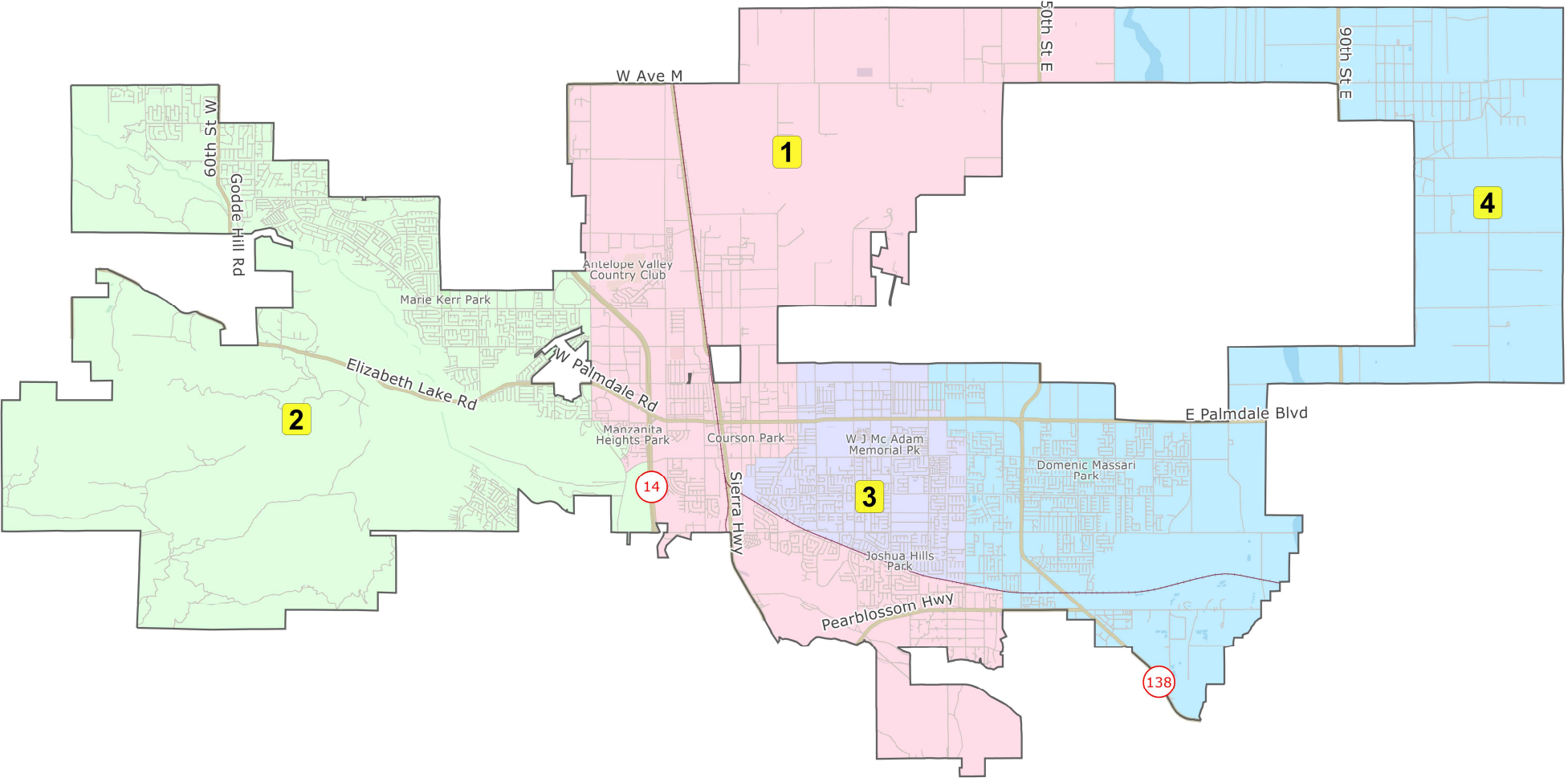

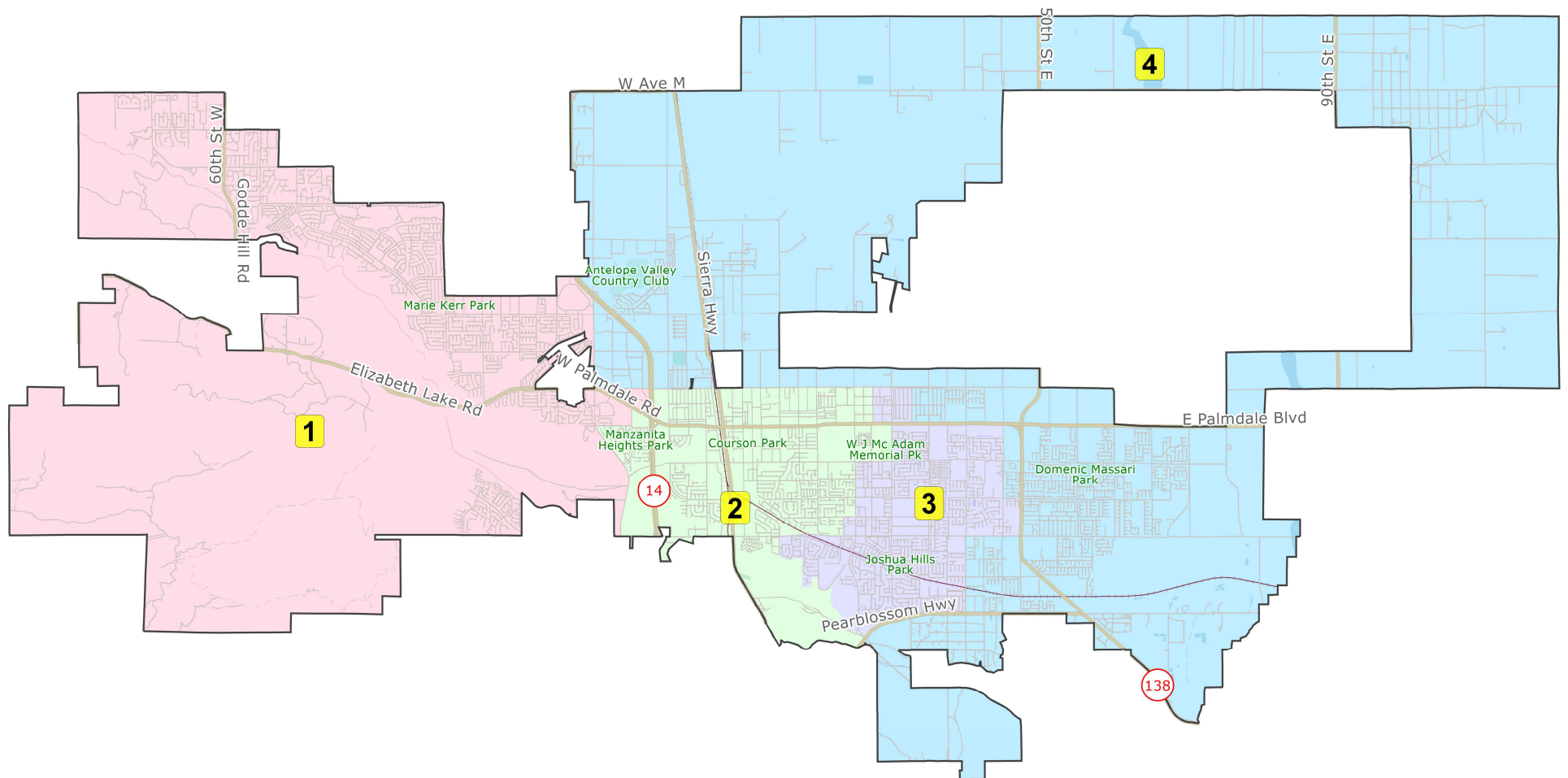

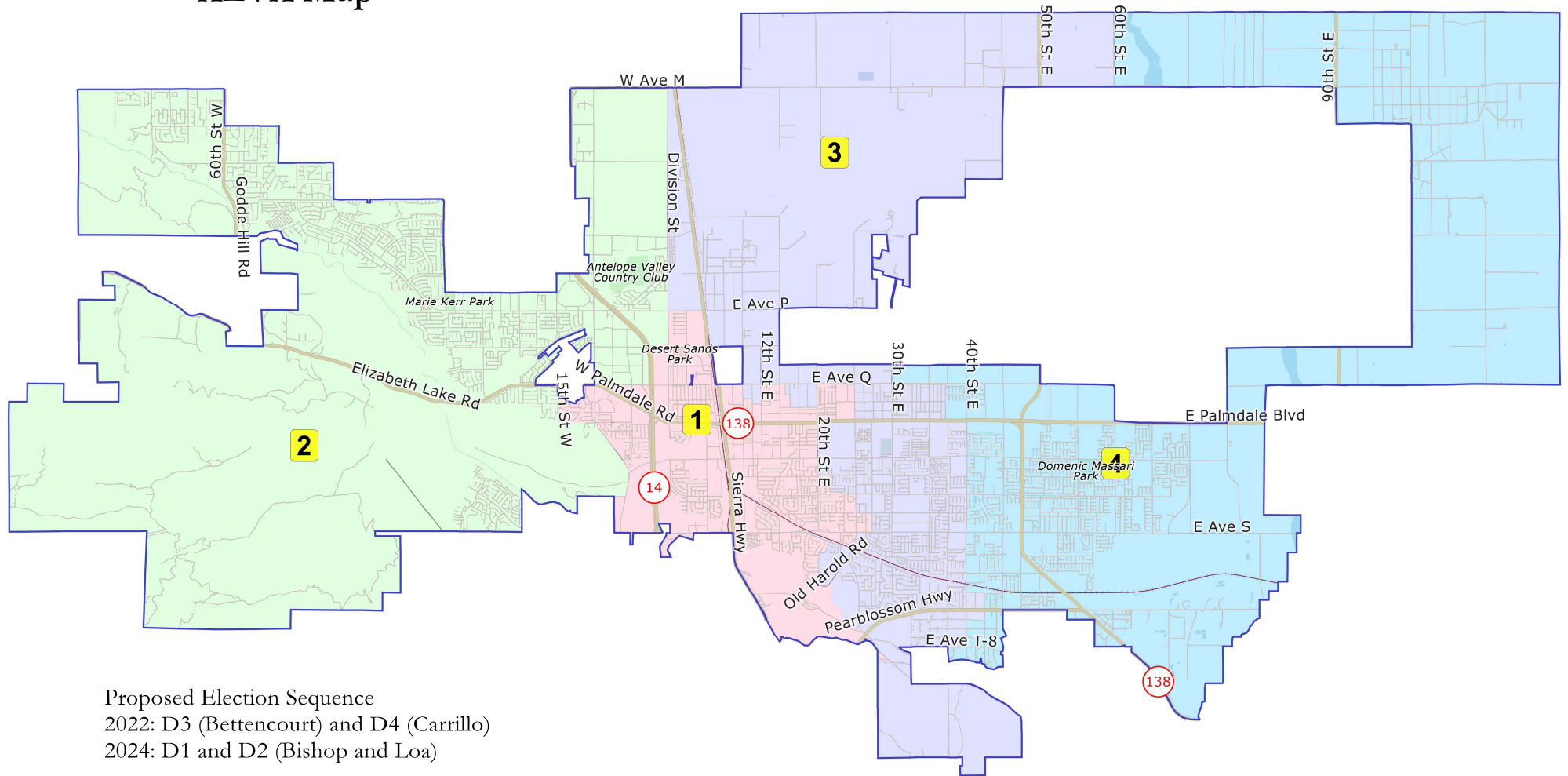

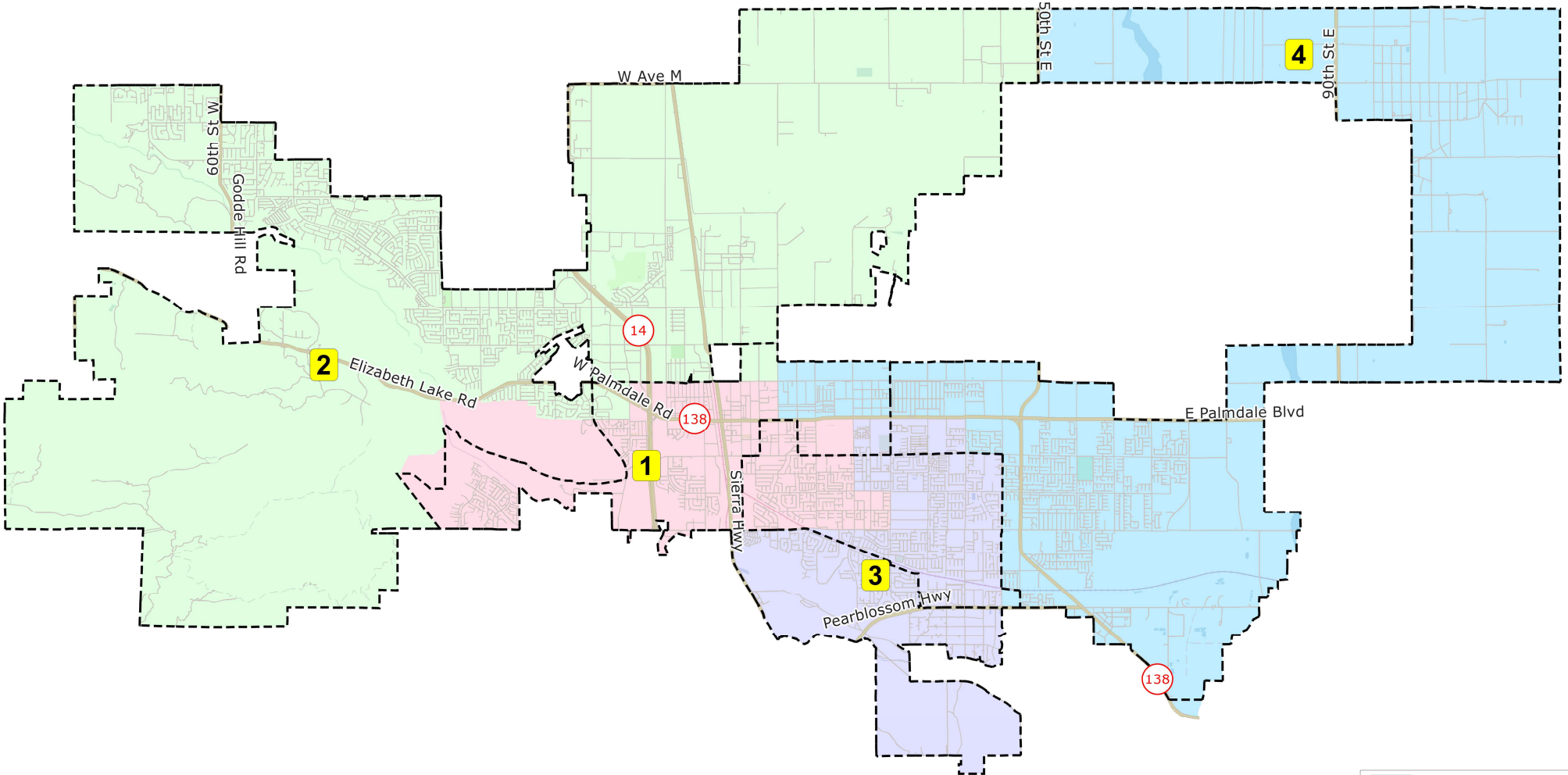
ALVA Map

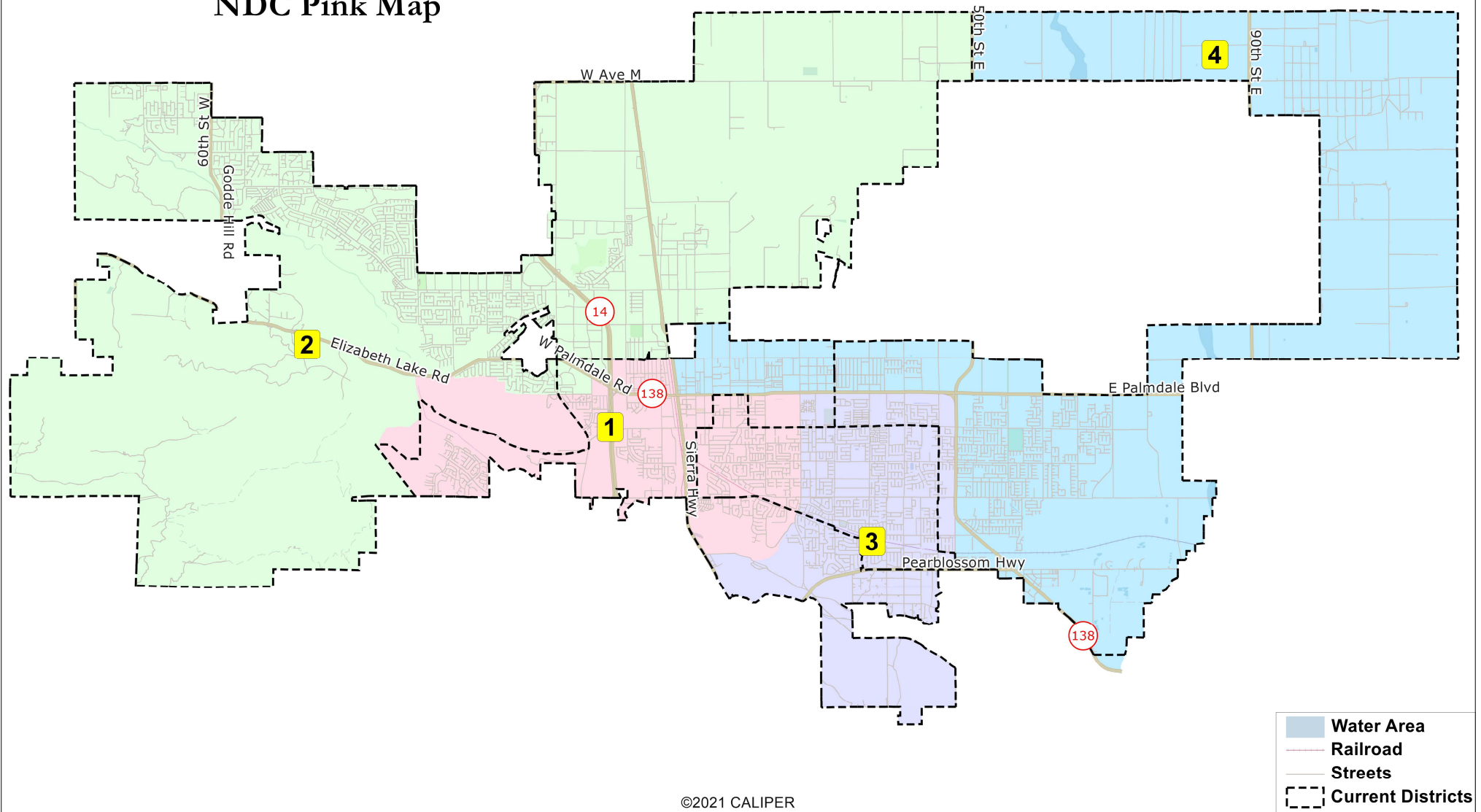
NDC Orange Map

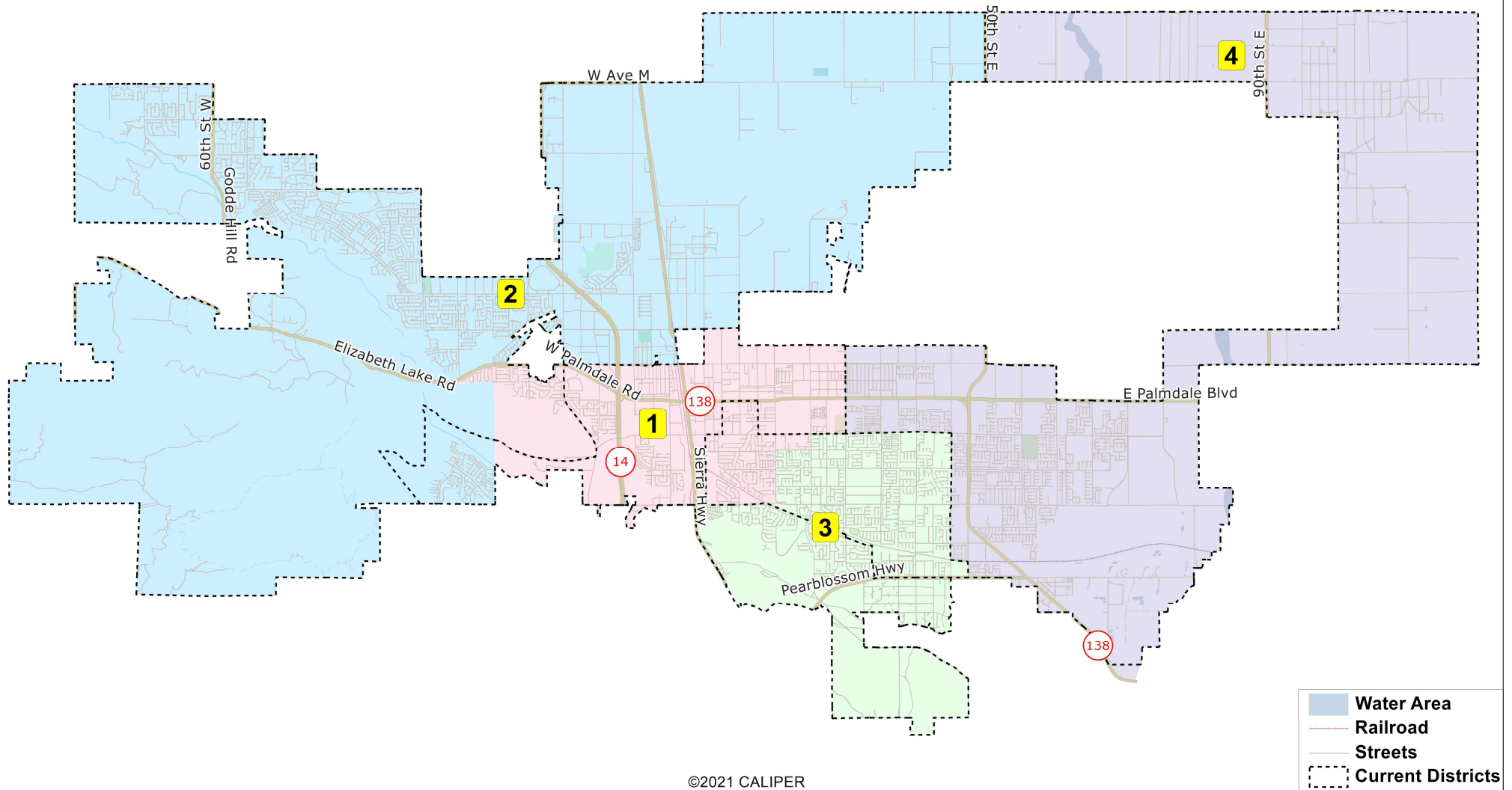
